



## Establishing Routines

The weekly overview is structured in a consistent manner across the school.

At 9.00am each day:

- Each class will start with a Morning Message delivered from your child's teacher – either through the *SeeSaw* or *Showbie* platforms.
- Daily lessons will appear in *SeeSaw* or *Showbie*. They contain the recommended learning for each day, under the headings English, Maths and Inquiry.

At 9.00am on a Monday:

- Weekly lessons will appear in *SeeSaw* or *Showbie*. These can be completed at any time during the week.

At 9.00am each fortnight on a Monday:

- The optional Activity Grid will be emailed home to parents. It will also be available in *Showbie* for students in years 4 - 6.

We recognise that families will need flexibility to structure their day and week depending on their own context. As a school, we make a number of key recommendations:

- Create a routine that suits your family.
- Use the weekly overview as a guide to assist you to establish this routine.
- Give priority to the completion of the daily lessons.
- Contact the school if you have any questions or concerns.

We have recorded a short video that shows students of different ages preparing a timetable of learning activities for the day. Please watch and take the time to consider what will work for your child and your family.

We encourage our families to end the day with a reflection and suggest a simple conversation that can occur at the dinner table or at the end of the formal learning.
