Attached to this email, you will see a daily overview for Tuesday 3 August.

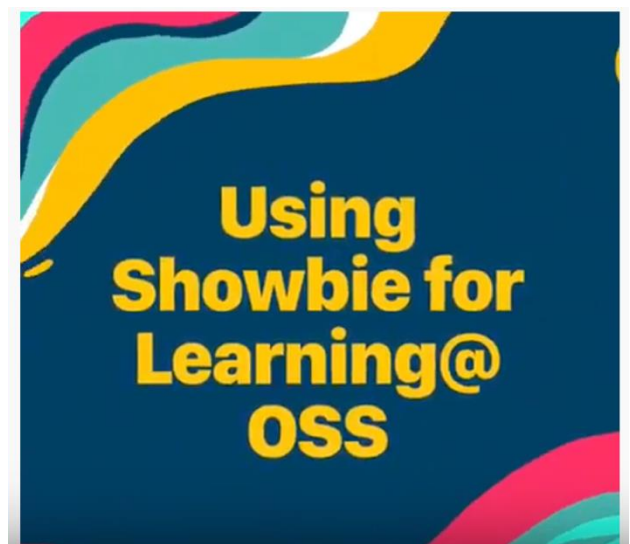
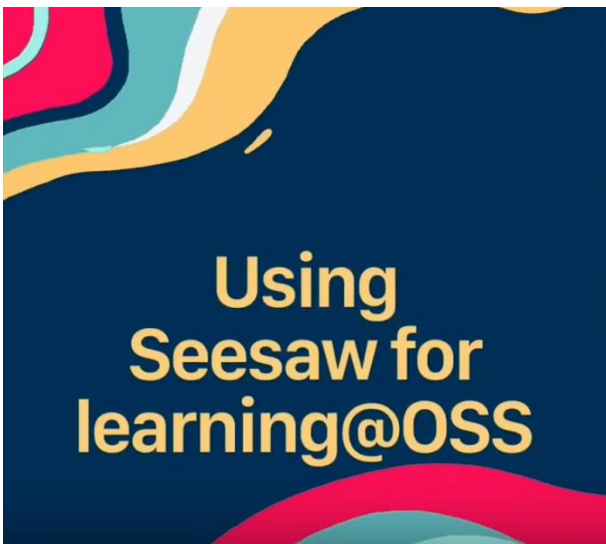
Each activity appearing on the daily overview has a lesson associated with it:

## Learning@OSS – Establishing Routines

The daily overview for Tuesday 3 August is attached to this email. This document is structured in a consistent way across the school.

By 7am on Tuesday 3 August:

- Daily activities will appear in *Showbie* or *Seesaw*. They contain the recommended learning for the day, under the headings English, Maths and Other.

By 9am on Tuesday:

- Each class will start with a Morning Message delivered by your child's teacher – either through the *Seesaw* or *Showbie* platforms.
- Encourage your child to plan their daily learning. Students and families have the flexibility to complete tasks when it suits your context.

Last year, during the extended learning from home period, we recorded some [short videos](#) that show students of different ages preparing a timetable of learning activities for the day. These might continue to be helpful in supporting your family to plan for learning.

## Communicating with teachers

Throughout the day when students are learning from home, teaching staff will be:

- supervising students of essential workers and vulnerable students
- communicating with students - monitoring and responding to student learning - using Seesaw or Showbie and using email for years 4 - 6
- communicating with parents and/or students - discussing specific questions and concerns
- preparing further learning materials.
