Staff Responsibilities



Plan, monitor and provide feedback on learning using checking for understanding activities.



Work with your teaching team to take ownership of the learning.



Be online for the morning message to students at 9am each day.



Stay connected. Look after each other. Use the range of staff platforms for collaboration.

Monitor student engagement in learning.

Model and engage in respectful communication.



Attend scheduled staff and team meetings.

Understand and appreciate that partnerships with parents and collaboration with your colleagues are key to success at this time.



Support students to participate in learning which is balanced.



Prioritise communication with parents and students in the allocated time-frame.

Student Responsibilities



Own your learning whilst working with your teacher and parents.



Plan your routine for learning with your parents.



Check SeeSaw, Showbie and, if appropriate, your email each morning.



Check your morning message each day at 9am.

Be cybersmart and cybersafe when using devices.



Communicate with your teachers when you need to.

Have regular brain breaks.



Respect the materials created by our teachers and do not share beyond our learning platforms.



Remember to use respectful communication at all times.

Reflect on your learning with your parents each day.

Parent Responsibilities



Engage with your child about what they are learning.



Consider a routine for each day that is balanced and appropriate for your own family.



Use Screen Time and other parent control mechanisms to restrict and manage online behaviour.



Support your child to attend the morning message at 9am each week day.

Encourage your child to read every day.



Support teachers by monitoring progress.

Engage in respectful communication at all times.



Respect the materials created by our teachers and do not permit sharing beyond our learning platforms.



Understand and appreciate that partnerships are key to success at this time.

Encourage your child to reflect on their learning each day.



Balance your use of screens with other activities.

Being eSmart and eSafe



Be respectful and use your manners online.



Be helpful and kind.
