

Recreational Tennis Court Hire – Terms and Conditions

Updated June 2018

The Oakleigh State School tennis courts are used for tennis coaching before and after school during term. Outside this purpose, the courts are available for casual or regular bookings to members of the broader community subject to these terms and conditions.

Use of the school courts is at the discretion of the Principal and hirers who breach these terms and conditions will have their bookings ceased.

- Courts are for playing tennis on a personal recreational use only and not for any commercial purposes. Those using the courts do so at their own risk.
- Hirers are asked to maintain modest social behaviour at all times, being mindful of the residential setting of the school. Hirers must extend common courtesy to the school's neighbours including keeping general noise to a minimum, such as loud conversations and outbursts on the court.
- Hours of availability for play are :
 - School Days – from 4pm to 9.30pm
 - Weekends and Non School Days – from 8am to 9.30pm
 - Lights to be turned off and premises vacated by 10pm at all times
- Any recreational court play outside of these times must be agreed with the school principal.
- Tennis Court Fees are set out below and may change without notice
 - \$10 per hour for daylight bookings
 - \$14 an hour for bookings when the lights are required
- Children under the age of 14 must be supervised when using the courts.
- No consumption of alcohol or smoking on the courts at any time
- All rubbish to be removed from courts and disposed of accordingly, leaving the area in a tidy state.
- The adjacent toilet block may be used and must be left in a clean state. The keys are available with the tennis court key. The keys provided are the property of Oakleigh State School and if lost a replacement fee of \$50 will be charged to the hirer.
- If the school becomes aware of any of the following, then the P&C has the right to cease the tennis hire:
 - Damage to property
 - Consumption of alcohol
 - Unsafe or dangerous behaviour
 - Smoking
 - Boisterous or noisy behaviour
